Academic excellence proven again...

Leighton Park's A-level and GCSE results once again demonstrate that hard work, talented students and dedicated staff are the right formula for excellent results across the whole curriculum. There are many success stories across the departments reflecting pupils' excellent results.

Leighton Park's strong academic track record across the whole range of A-level subjects can be seen. An overall pass rate of 99.6% means this is the eighth year running that the A-level pass rate has been 98% or higher. A-level Maths again proved extremely popular, with nearly half of the whole year group taking the subject and no less than 71% achieving A*-B grades.

At GCSE, Leighton Park pupils again bucked national trends. Despite the national downturn in the popularity of science, students taking Physics excelled, gaining an impressive 100% pass rate with 76% achieving A*/A. 36 out of 69 students took History with 81% achieving A*/A. Subjects which saw a 100% pass rate at grades A*-C were Art & Design, Chemistry, Chinese, Drama, Russian, History, Latin, Maths, Physics, Spanish and Greek.

A-Level Results

- ◆ For the eighth successive year, students have achieved a pass rate of 98% or above and an average of three or more A-level passes each
- ◆ 39.5% of all passes were grade A*/A
- ◆ 70% of all passes were grade A*-B

GCSE Results

- ◆ 99% of pupils achieved five or more passes at grades A*-C
- ◆ 53% of all grades were A*/A (10% up on 2009); 22% were A*
- ◆ Pupils achieved an average of 9.4 passes each

NB: As is the case each year, the national statistics when published show different figures which can be misleading. This is in part because the Department for Education counts only those pupils aged 15 on a certain date in the year, rather than all pupils taking GCSEs in Year 11, which would reflect the achievements of each year group more accurately. The complete results are given here.
