Mandatory subjects

Mathematics, English and Additional Science GCSEs are compulsory for all our Pre-Sixth students. The Additional Science GCSE consists of equal parts of Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Native German speakers are also encouraged to take an introduction to German Literature, in preparation for the IB.

Optional subjects

Students can select one from each of the following GCSE option blocks:

Block 1: French or Spanish. Latin is also available on request. Students should have a prior knowledge of the selected language, but it should not be their first language.
