### 'Frankenstein' at the Aylesbury Waterside Theatre

### A level Drama Education Visit

I am delighted to be able to offer an educational visit to our current Lower and Upper Sixth A Level Drama students to see *Frankenstein* on stage at the Aylesbury Waterside Theatre on **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020** at **2.30pm**, as part of their course.

This play is a set text for the students and forms part of their written exam in the 'Analysing Performance' component.

In the exam, students must be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of how extracts from *Frankenstein* can be rehearsed and interpreted in performance, showing an awareness of characterisation, performance style, genre and context. They are expected to understand the opening 10 minutes of the text and at least three additional scenes from across the text. For this reason, the board recommends the students are taken to see the play in production as well as read the play as part of their exploration.

This is a wonderful opportunity for them as the play is not always available to see during a course, but we are fortunate a production has come up this term and in good proximity over in Aylesbury.

We will **leave Leighton Park at 1pm** and make our way to the theatre in a school minibus. Once there, students will enjoy the production and make production notes to use as a resource for their own practice questions. We will take a packed lunch with us and expect to **return back to Leighton Park by approximately 7pm**. There is a café in the theatre which students are welcome to use should they wish to.

#### The cost of the visit is £25.00.
