International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme Results

While some schools only recommend the IB Diploma for their top academic students, Leighton Park sees the value of the programme for individuals who have an international outlook, enjoy coursework and interdisciplinary projects.

One such student is our Head Student, Will, who achieved 40 out of 45 points and is going to the University of Warwick to study Maths. Against the global average of 30 and a passmark of 24, this year's cohort achieved an average of 31.5 points.
